MSCI Climate Change Indices aim to represent the performance of an investment strategy that adjusts the weights of securities according to the opportunities and risks related to climate change and the transition to a low-carbon economy.

To assist investors in capitalizing on investment opportunities associated with these indices, ICE introduced the following futures contracts:

- MSCI Europe Climate Change NTR Index Futures (EUR)
- MSCI USA Climate Change NTR Index Futures (USD)
- MSCI World Climate Change NTR Index (USD)


MSCI Climate Change Indices

These indices build on MSCI's existing low-carbon and environmental indexes, with a distinct focus on reducing exposure to "stranded assets", while increasing exposure to low-carbon solution providers. They are designed to exceed the minimum standards of the EU Climate Transition Benchmark (CTB).

The MSCI Climate Change methodology uses the MSCI Low Carbon Transition (LCT) score and category to reweight constituents of a parent index. Exclusions from the parent index are minimized.
